LEAVING THE PREMISES



Young people come to youth service activities and sessions voluntarily, and youth workers encourage them to remain for the entire session.

It should be noted by parents that while youth workers will take all reasonable steps to supervise the young people attending such activities and sessions, they cannot force young people to remain in the premises against their wishes.

Parents and guardians are therefore requested to have a conversation with their young person regarding the expectation that they will attend for the duration of the sessions and that they should seek permission from their parents if they wish to leave the premises.

Once they leave the youth club/centre premises, the Youth Service and its staff cannot accept responsibility for the young person and will not be supervising the young person.

The youth club will allow the young person to access a telephone should they wish to contact you for permission to leave, subject to the young person notifying a youth worker that they are leaving.
